**ORDER**

As per the Government order read as 1st paper above, inter-district transfer to teachers could be allowed only after the completion of 3 years service in the district of recruitment. As per the Government order read as 2nd paper above, the service required for getting inter-district transfer has been enhanced to 5 years.

2. As per the Government order read as 3rd, 4th and 5th paper above the condition has been relaxed in respect of transfers to districts of Kasaragod, Wayanad, Idukki and Attappadi in Palakkad district in addition to the relaxation available in respect of relatives of Jawans.

3. The Director of Public Instruction in his letter read as 6th paper above has brought to the notice of Government, the acute shortage of Government school teachers in difficult areas including Kuttanadu and has requested to relax the 5 year rule for inter-district transfer in the case of teachers who are willing to work for a minimum period of 5 years in remote/forest/tribal areas.

4. The Secretary, Kerala Public Service Commission in his letter read above has agreed to the proposal subject to obtaining willingness/undertaking from teachers concerned to serve in the difficult areas for a minimum period of 5 years.

5. Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to order that, the stipulation of completion of 5 years service in the District in which first appointment is got, for getting inter-district transfer is dispensed with in the case of teachers who aspire to get transfer to the difficult areas as enlisted in the appendix to this Government order, subject to obtaining their willingness/undertaking to work in such difficult areas for a minimum period of 5 years.
