ORDER

As per Rule 14 (1) (i) of the Rules for the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education 2011, the bio-metric identification details along with the Unique Identification Number (UID) of each child should be maintained in the school. In some cases it could be noticed that the Rules has not been followed in the recognised unaided schools in strict sense. Since UID has already become obligatory in Government as well as in Aided Schools, Government hereby order that U.I.D is mandatory for admission to all classes in all the recognised unaided schools in the State.
